Brief Description of Best Practice: SRS utilized a standard work week critique format for its 24 Site Facilities

Why the Best Practice was used: To have the ability to compare information from the Work Week Critiques of all facilities.

What are the benefits of the Best Practice: Allows the comparison of information, including tracking & trending across Facilities, etc.

What problems/issues were associated with the Best Practice: Determining a standard format that all Facilities could use.

How the success of the Best Practice was measured: In the ability to share information across Facilities.

Description of process experience using the Best Practice:

A standardized format & metrics facilitates common work week critique report understanding by personnel across all Facilities. Standardization of metrics allows metrics for all Facilities to be auto generated from a central reporting function, rather than each Facility having to generate individual reports.
