Throughout her career, Ms. Porter has led several critical initiatives for Lockheed Martin, including advanced programs (proposal execution) management, engineering and operations management for the Defense Messaging System, database design and software development for the Global Transportation Network all for Lockheed Martin's Mission Systems.
