Greg Meyer has over 35 years of nuclear operations and safety experience. As Senior Vice President for Operations, Greg is responsible for Fluor Corporation's Environmental and Nuclear business line, which includes operations serving the Department of Energy, the National Nuclear Security Administration and the National Decommissioning Authority in the UK.

Before joining Fluor, Greg served four years at the National Nuclear Security Administration's Pantex Plant, half that time as President and General Manager. In addition to his NNSA assignment, he has held significant senior management positions in operations, project management and project support at three other Department of Energy sites: Hanford, Richland, Washington; Savannah River, Aiken, South Carolina, and Rocky Flats, Golden, Colorado. He has been a nuclear operations project manager, a safeguards and security director and an Environment, Safety, Health and Quality director.

Mr. Meyer completed a 24-year career in the U. S. Navy. A graduate of the Naval Nuclear Propulsion Program, he served on five nuclear submarines and two submarine squadron staffs. Highlights of his career included assignment as Commanding Officer of the USS Scranton (SSN-756) and an overseas diplomatic post in Geneva, Switzerland, where he was the Joint Chiefs of Staff Representative to the Conference on Disarmament and a senior member of the U.S. Delegation that negotiated the Comprehensive Nuclear Test Ban treaty.

Mr. Meyer received his BS in marine engineering from the U.S. Naval Academy and MS in nuclear engineering from the University of Wisconsin. He is a graduate of the National War College.
