

Dr. G. Todd Wright

Dr. Todd Wright is the Executive Vice President and General Manager of the Nuclear & Environment Strategic Business Unit of AECOM's Management Services Group. He has operations management responsibility for AECOM's work with the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE), UK Nuclear Decommissioning Authority (NDA), and intercontinental commercial clients.

He oversees Nuclear & Environment's (NE) day-to-day operations; manages profit and loss, strategic initiatives and business development; and oversees administrative and operations support functions. He has management responsibility for the strategic business unit, which encompasses the management and operation of complex nuclear and chemical sites, project management at high-hazard facilities, safety management, nuclear component fabrication, nuclear decommissioning, nuclear material management/treatment, and technology development. As EVP, Dr. Wright has strengthened NE performance in Nuclear Operation, while expanding growth reflected in the selection of AECOM-Energy Solutions for decommissioning of the San Onofre Nuclear site.

Dr. Wright has 37 years of leadership experience in managing complex nuclear site operations, project management, contractor assurance, advanced research and development, and achieving safety performance excellence. In leadership positions at three of the most complex nuclear sites in the world and a U.S. National Laboratory, he has successfully led complex organizations and managed unprecedented change in highly regulated environments. He is the former Managing Director for Sellafield Ltd.; and the former Laboratory Director of the Savannah River National Laboratory.

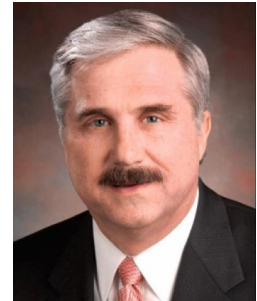
As the Managing Director for Sellafield Sites, one of the world's most complex nuclear sites, he led the efforts to bring safety performance at Sellafield Ltd. to the best ever in its 60-year history, earning the corporate honor of Safe Project of the Year for an unprecedented two consecutive years. He led Sellafield to achieve significantly improved nuclear safety performance, and led efforts to build a foundation for sustained operations performance in both workforce culture and infrastructure improvements.

At DOE's Savannah River Site, Dr. Wright served as the Laboratory Director at the Savannah River National Laboratory, successfully transitioning the laboratory from a site-centered focused Laboratory to a national research program with a diverse portfolio of new customers. Under his leadership, revenue for the Laboratory was significantly increased over 35% while several innovative initiatives were realized, including the construction and establishment of the Center for Hydrogen Research.

Most recently, he was appointed as a representative to the U.S. Department of Commerce Civil Nuclear Trade Advisory Committee by Commerce Secretary Penny Pritzker in 2015.

Dr. Wright has led work in all of the processes of the back end of the nuclear fuel cycle, including High Level Waste Operations.

Dr. Wright earned his PhD, Master's, and Baccalaureate degrees in Mechanical Engineering from Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University with specialization in thermal fluid sciences and chemical thermodynamics.
