Rick Provencher is the Chief Executive Officer with Cavendish Nuclear (USA) Incorporated, based in Arlington, VA. In this capacity, he is responsible for establishing and leading business operations in the U.S. In the areas of nuclear D&D, waste management, and environmental remediation and the application of proven technologies that will streamline waste characterization, removal, and disposal efforts. Mr. Provencher retired from the U.S. Department of Energy in 2018 after having served 33 years with the DOE and Nuclear Regulatory Commission.
