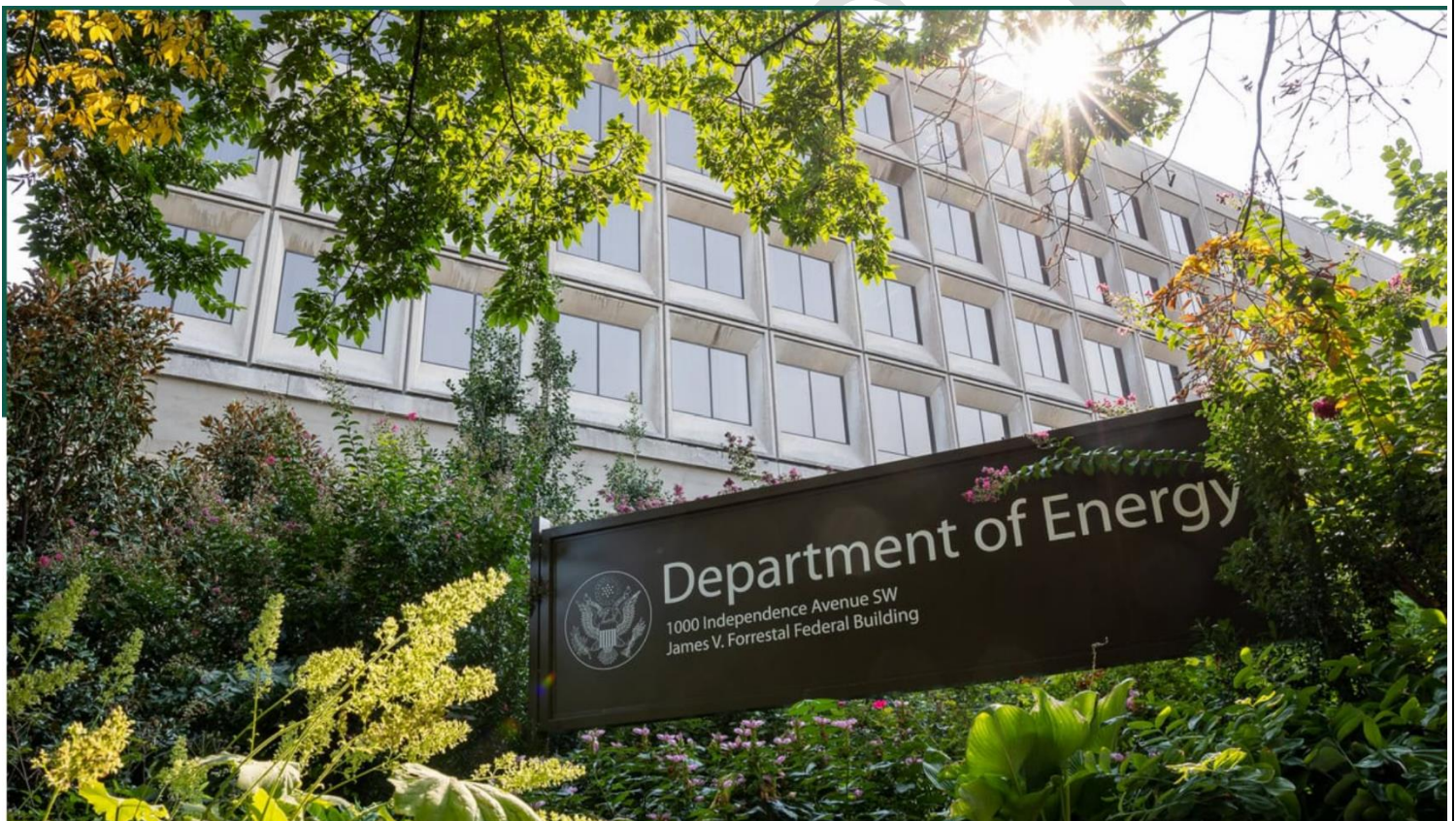

SPEAKERS:

Computerized Accident Incident Reporting System (CAIRS) #101 - Craig Schumann DOE HQ

Description: In this session, "CAIRS #101," attendees will be given a brief introductory overview of the injury/illness reporting requirements within DOE. This will include the regulatory reporting requirements found in DOE Order 231.1B and the significance of injury/illness rates throughout DOE...and most importantly gain an understanding of the difference between CAIRS and ORPS reporting!

Craig Schumann is the CAIRS program manager for EHSS-23 and also currently serves as the Chair for the DOE Construction Safety Advisory Committee. Prior to this assignment, Craig was a Senior Facility Representative at the Argonne Site Office for approximately 25 years primarily involved in industrial and construction safety oversight.

Chemical Lifecycle Management 2.0 at Berkeley Lab – Chenxi Sun LBNL

Description: Berkeley Lab has recently completed a comprehensive improvement effort to its Chemical Lifecycle Management Program. This initiative involved converting all hazardous chemical containers on site to RFID tracking, implementing a new Chemical Management System (CMS), and establishing a temporary Central Chemical Receiving Facility during the construction of the permanent facility. Additionally, a site-wide chemical inventory reconciliation was conducted using RFID technology. We are excited to share our journey behind these changes.

Chenxi Sun is the Chemical Management Specialist for Berkeley Lab, where he has been for 4 years. He has a master's in industrial Hygiene from the University of Michigan and a bachelor's in chemistry from Carleton College. In his spare time, he likes playing ultimate frisbee and trying new local restaurants.

Description: Worker Safety and Health SMEs at NNSA have been in collaboration to construct a module enabling users at M&Os, Field Offices, and HQ to better understand the state of their Worker Safety and Health programs across the complex. SAFER integrates data from centralized sources, such as ORPS and CAIRS, alongside data from the sites, such as issues management and vehicle incident data, and leverages that data with several tools including artificial intelligence models.
