Commissioned as an officer in the U.S. Navy in 1985, Juan served six years as a nuclear propulsion officer in the submarine fleet, earning the Navy Commendation and two Navy Achievement medals. He holds a Bachelor's degree in Education from the University of Miami and a Master's in Industrial Technology from the University of Idaho. Juan is a member of several boards and committees associated with the management of national laboratories contributing his extensive experience and leadership to the advancement of scientific research and development.
