- Developing a risk-based approach to conducting work to detect and eliminate or resolve issues early
- Developing a performance assurance maturity model to self-assess effectiveness of risk management programs
- Recommending actions for accelerating infrastructure projects (use of commercial standards, accelerated decision making, simplified reporting and expanding supply chains)
- Developing approaches for accelerating introduction of digital tools/AI to improve mission delivery
- Analyzing long-term workforce needs and workforce development programs
- Establishing cyber security best practices and conducting cyber tabletop exercises

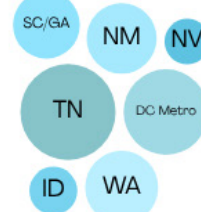
