Ryan Matthews is Chief Business Officer at Honeywell Federal Manufacturing & Technologies (FM&T), which manages and operates the Department of Energy's Kansas City National Security Campus (KCNSC). With nearly 7,000 employees in Kansas City, Missouri, and Albuquerque, New Mexico, KCNSC provides diverse engineering, manufacturing and secure sourcing services for national security.

In this position, Ryan serves as single point of accountability to the President & CEO for the execution of business and administrative functions performed on the KCNSC Management and Operating contract. This position is directly responsible for over 1,100 professional and administrative employees in the areas of Safeguards & Security; Counterintelligence; Health, Safety, Environment & Facilities; Operational Excellence; and Internal Audit.

Ryan has been with KCNSC for over 16 years, previously serving as the Interim Director of the New Mexico Operations leading all major programmatic, engineering, global security and integrated supply chain activities in New Mexico, and as the Chief Financial Officer supporting all aspects of the accounting and financial function. His management experience spreads across the departments of financial planning and analysis, sales, resource, operations, planning, strategic sourcing and Global Security. He has experience with other sites across the Nuclear Security Enterprise and led the finance transitions for both the Sandia National Laboratories and Nevada National Security Site.

Prior to joining KCNSC, Ryan served in financial capacities for State Street Investment in Kansas City, Missouri; United Parcel Service in Atlanta; and YRC Worldwide in Overland Park, Kansas, where he led a budget team with an oversight of \$3 billion and participated on a merger and acquisition team with the successful merger of a \$3 billion company.
