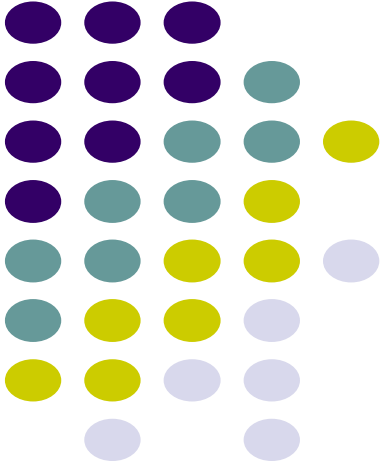


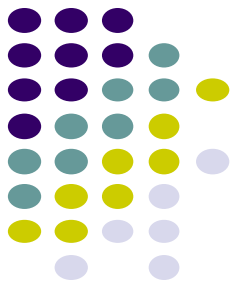

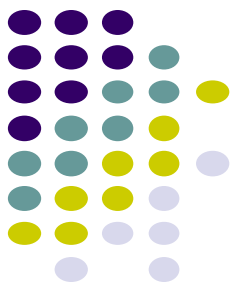

# Working Group Strategic Initiatives

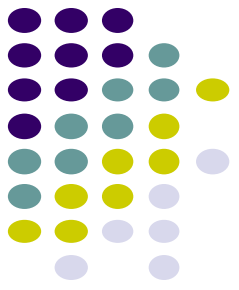
- Continued Glovebox collaboration meetings

# FY23 Key Achievements

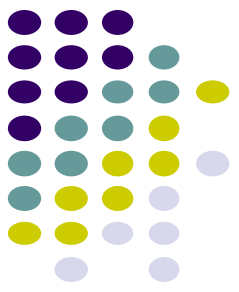


- Conducted first Supply Chain Workshop with strong site participation across DOE Complex

# FY 2024 Upcoming Focus Areas and Planned Achievements



- Advance Supply Chain Risk Management Strategies for Top 4 Challenges
  - #1 – Delays and Price Spikes in Parts Supply Market
  - #2 – Supplier Capability/Capacity for unique, non-commercial items
  - #3 – Supply Chain staffing insufficient to satisfy increasing scope demands
  - #4 – Overburdensome Federal Requirements' impact on Supply Chain
- Best Practice Sharing among sites to strengthen capabilities

- Cybersecurity – Supply base not prepared to meet NIST-800.171 & Cybersecurity Maturity Model Certification (CMMC) requirements (Collaborate with Cyber team)
