Forrestal Building Ground Floor & MCR East Wing-Locations

The EFRCOG-CES location for Monday is at DOE's Forrestal Building

The HOW TO GET TO DOE guide:

U.S. Dept. of Energy, 1000 Independence Ave., SW Washington, DC 20585

To DOE via Taxi Service:

From Dulles Airport, cost is approximately \$40.00. From National Airport, cost is approximately \$15.00.

To DOE via Automobile:

From Dulles Airport follow signs for I-66 East (Washington). Take 495 towards Baltimore. Take the George Washington Memorial Parkway exit. Follow that until you get to the 395 North exit (Washington). Take the 14th Street Bridge to 14th Street. Turn right at the second traffic light on Independence Avenue. Cross 12th Street, Turn right on L'Enfant Plaza, drive under the DOE building and park. Parking meters there accept only \$2 worth of quarters at a time which equates to 2 hours.

From National Airport follow signs for 395 North (Washington). Take the 14th Street Bridge to 14th Street. Turn right at the second traffic light on Independence Avenue. Cross 12th Street, Turn right on L'Enfant Plaza, drive under the DOE building and park. Parking meters there accept only \$2 worth of guarters at a time which equates to 2 hours.

To DOE via Metro Rail from National Airport:

There are free airport shuttles that will take you to the Metro Rail Train Station at the airport or you can easily walk. The station is on an elevated platform across from the main terminal and down the street from the auxiliary terminal. Metro rail stations open weekdays at 5:30 am and close between 11:00 pm and midnight depending on the train schedule.

Fare rate schedules are posted next to all fare card machines and station kiosk personnel are available if assistance is required All stations are handicap accessible. From National Airport to L'Enfant Station (DOE) the one way charge is \$1.05 during rush hours and \$1.00 at other times.

The fare card machines will accept \$1 and \$5 bills. You cannot cash in unused fare card amounts but you can put in the round trip fare on one card and use it twice. If you put in more than the amount required just depress the downward arrows under the dollar amount display. When the amount is correct depress the ticket button at the right.

You put your fare card in ticket gates at both entry and exit points. The fare card computers determine your fare. All fare cards and fare machines have arrows pointing the correct way to insert the cards.

Two separate routes share the track at the Airport: GET ON THE YELLOW LINE

The Train type will be posted in the operators window facing forward on the first car of the train and also a small colored strip will be in the sign on the side of each car. If that sign reads Yellow (Stripe) /Huntington DO NOT GET ON THAT TRAIN; it is going in the opposite direction

that you want; you are also on the wrong side of the tracks. You want to get on a train with a sign that reads Yellow (Stripe)/Mt. Vernon Square.

Go to L'Enfant Plaza stop and exit the train. The L'Enfant Station has several exits to the street level. THE MALL exit is the closest exit to the Department of Energy. If you take the escalator you will come up facing away from DOE. Turn around and cross 6th Street and walk west along C Street (You will know you are going in the right direction if you see train tracks on your left and a white marble building with silver tinted windows on your right as you walk west along C Street.). You will get to a dark concrete building with recessed glass windows but no signs. Step up onto the sidewalk next to the windows, turn right and walk along the building until you get to the main entrance around the corner.

Once inside you will need to sign in at the Visitor station and show some identification. At the guard station you will be asked to place your bags on a conveyor for X-Ray inspection, and walk through a metal detector. Obviously, avoid weapons since these are not permitted. Bringing portable computers might be a hassle; if they are government property, you will need to get a property pass to remove it from the building.

From the Lobby take the down escalator through the sliding glass door and Go passed the elevator bank and take an immediate left and go straight to the first right then go to the 2nd door on your left GH027.

The EFCOG-CES location for Tuesday and Wednesday is at the MCR Building

MCR address is 600 Maryland Ave., SW, Suite 820E.

Our building is called the Capital Gallery and is located adjacent to the L'Enfant Plaza Metro Station. The L'Enfant Plaza Metro is serviced by the Orange, Blue, Green and Yellow lines.

When getting off the metro be sure to take the 7^{th} Street and Maryland Ave. exit. That will put you at the entrance to the 7^{th} Street side or west side of the building.

The building has two wings, east and west. We are located in the east wing, which can be identified by the location of the Wells Fargo Bank on the ground floor.

For those who will be driving, parking is available in our building (entrance to the parking garage is on the 6^{th} Street side or east side of the building). Additional parking is available at the Holiday Inn on 6^{th} Street.

We are open from 8AM to 5PM.
