#### **Status of Our Initiatives**

An update was provided on our initiatives:

FAR-Based Contract MR Management (Winship/Thomas): The progress on this initiative is progressing with the deployment of new IDIQ end state contract. As part of the EFCOG Acquisition Group's initiative we will be providing the Risk Management lessons learned section of that report. J. R. Thomas is awaiting a response from the EFCOG Acquisition Group as to what will be required as Risk Management input.

Bias Management (Ramirez): Work is continuing on training package development. A draft training package will be provided to the Team for review shortly.

Managing risks via vertical transfer (Winship, Lane): Richard Lane is working on this initiative and developing the paper. Richard is incorporating methodologies provided by team members and has solicited and received additional input as to how risks are elevated at different sites. A draft report will be provided to the Team for review shortly.

Utilizing weather calendars for weather-related risks (Winship/Wright): The draft report has been reviewed by the team and is routed for approval.

Risk Management Guidance Cross-Walk (Wright): Work has started on the FY21 update to reflect new best practices/requirements and to identify any additional candidate initiatives the team may wish to include in future work plans. Team members are asked to identify new or revised requirements/guidance that are applicable to risk management and forward the information to Bryan Wright for inclusion in the cross-walk (Action 8.1)
