ISM-HPI-23-01 Support EHSS-20 revision of DOE- HDBK-1028-2009, Human Performance Improvement Handbook	 Human Performance Tools for Individuals, Work Teams, and Management were written in June 2009. They have become the core reference documents for many users both within and outside the DOE complex. These updates will help expand the scope of the Department's HPI programs by encompassing Human and Organizational Performance (HOP) This effort will result in significant revisions to the Handbooks, with an estimated twenty-five percent change to Volume 1 and a fifty percent change to Volume 2. The content and the approach to the topics will be based on concepts and practices found helpful in the commercial nuclear power industry, electrical grid and distribution, national laboratories, and those adopted by other sectors. 	The EFCOG HPI Task Team will collaborate with EHSS-20 to select EFCOG team members. EHSS-20 will identify the specific updates that will be made by the team revising the Handbooks. The team will be composed of a Federal Project Lead with academic and technical experts. Team members will include subject-matter experts from DOE M&O contractors and thought leaders from outside the DOE complex.

2) HPI Share: HPI proposal for revision of DOE-STD-1197-2011, DOE Occurrence Reporting Tree

- Andy Hobbs information on updating the A3 Cause Codes in the DOE Causal Analysis Tree (CAT)
 - Mike displayed the redlines Andy has made to the DOE Standard
 - Had discussion; basis for this change comes from the A3 branch; a lot of historical data involved with the trend codes that have been used; it is difficult to change the trend codes that already exist; proposed to create an additional set of trend codes that could be transitioned to and used in the future. Mike reviewed the Skill, Rule, and Knowledge based B nodes, and "other" performance problems that don't fit into Skill, Rule, or Knowledge
 - Looking at definitions for each, too
 - Mike sent out last month for people to provide feedback to Andy
 - Nancy from Princeton use the word "violation" a lot doesn't know if that is how everyone else is reading it, but doesn't know if that is the appropriate wording
 - Andy was able to call in and reviewed the changes and the thought/methodology

What Andy did with DOE-STD-1197-2011 was intended in part to bring the coding scheme into better alignment with the Handbook. As Volume 1 of the Handbook is updated, care should be taken to preserve its existing treatment of concepts referenced in 1197 as revised, and perhaps add background material on things that Andy has introduced, e.g., Don Norman's foundational work on error categorization. Similarly, it may be useful to bolster the Handbook's treatment of culpability, since Andy's revision of DOE-STD-1197-2011 makes reference to intentions, incapacity, etc.

Bechtel: Gale Voyles

Working the document on both sides. I will give updates to Andy. Significant number of management does not know about these details. This is good for the causal analysts.

PPPL: Nancy Van Wermeskerken

PPPL conducted a lunch and learn. Next focus area is on questioning attitude. What gets in the way of asking questions. Send out email highlighted Jakes webinars, provided food, hybrid meeting, and then a "throw them into the deep end" give us a situation that did not go as planned and do an AAR.
