### NUMBER OF ESRAS

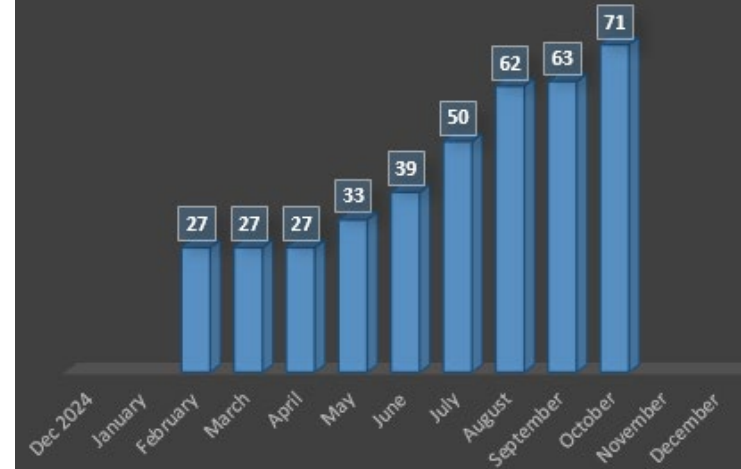

### NUMBER OF CYBER

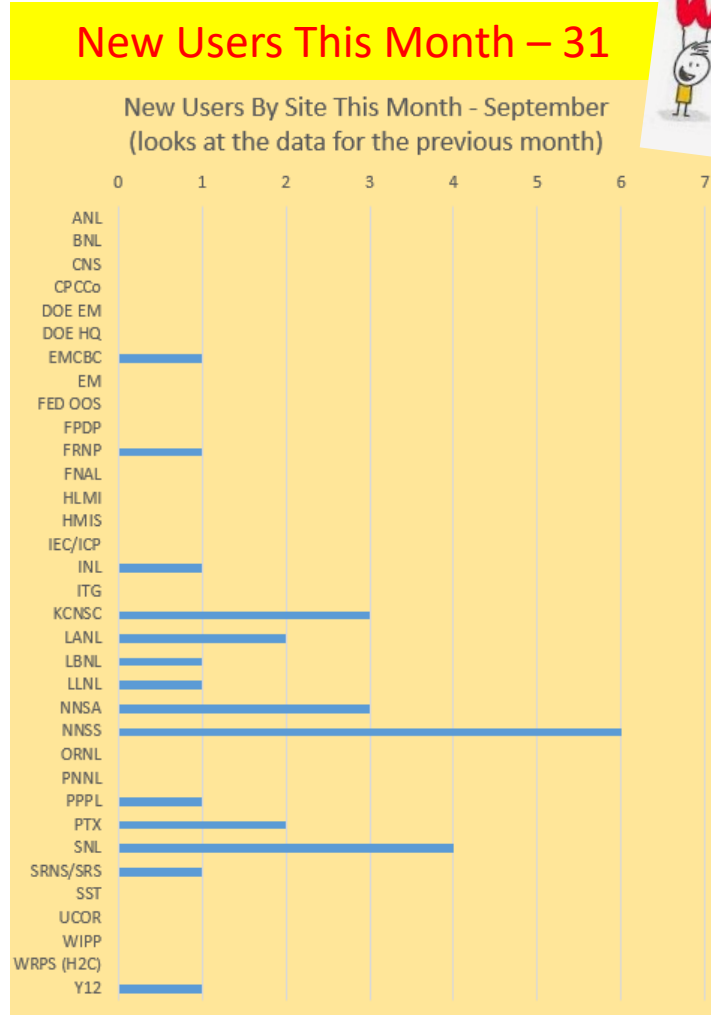


Cybersecurity Desk Assessments

## MSL Request Issues

Users checking all the boxes for Portal, Agreements, Scorecards and MSL.

**\*\* If you don't need MSL access, do not check the box for it \*\***

Your access is being verified to assure you truly need it.

Please remember the kind of information in MSL. If not needed, it will be removed from your access request.

### Reason for access

Be clear on the reasons why you need access to each of these. Saying because you 'Need to Know' is not a valid reason. **IMPORTANT!!! If you are a POC at a site, please respond in a timely manner when you see an email from the MSL support mailbox.**

- **MSL** houses external supplier assessments/audit information, approval statuses from other sites, risk and cyber assessments and exigent reports. If you purchase for production or work with suppliers that are doing development/prototype work, this is appropriate for you. You must have NTK (Need to Know) to access this system and there is an additional approval process. Edit users are now required to attend training prior to making updates.
- **Agreements** houses a huge amount of information around suppliers and purchasing: agreements, small business resources, catalogs, an interested supplier database, training, etc. This is usually the more general information procurement users need, agreements and what sites already use the companies, etc.
- **Scorecard** data is a visual summary of savings, eSourcing and spend (this is not available for all sites)

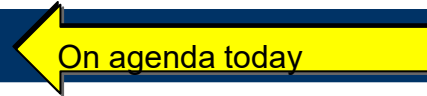
