 - *Remember to share information and avoid supplier relationship strains associated with multiple/duplicated audits.
 - *Remember NOT to tell suppliers they will not be audited for 3 years if in MSL (other sites could require different standards, or the audit material may not be acceptable for some sites)

*Remember to include SMEs (DOT packaging, welding) on supplier audits (not a requirement, but a good practice)

Sandia will be impacted by DOD cuts and is also trying to brace for any DOE cuts such as those expected for Office of Science (see other articles from same URL). At this time our Mission Support areas which include SCRM activities that support vendor background check are refrained from growth.
