We are already sharing audits, why not share this additional information with each other? Target would be suppliers that handle weapon drawings. Barbara Siciliano (in chat) – She believes there is sharing already in place. Chief Information Security Officer (CISOs) are already in touch and Security Ops Cntr (SOC) reports are shared. She thinks there is a lot of work already being done. PNNL could be a hub but need to do a benchmarking exercise to see what is already out there. When you start digging into companies about how they are handling their data, we need to understand companies who are selling
		and who are using software to support. This requires a study.

		Kristin Bell — Cybersecurity at Sandia already has a checklist/survey that they have already used when visiting suppliers that Sandia deals with. This was an evaluation on their security. Whether it can be staffed full time or not, it is valuable information they have collected for possible ideas. Bill — LANL has group that asks those questions (similar)

MSL Compliance Team – ALWAYS search for the supplier first!!! The correct way to add a new assessment is find supplier, find location under that supplier, then upload assessment on that location. DO NOT create a new supplier without checking for it first. This is creating more work for the MSL team to resolve the duplicates. Any questions, please contact MSL support at mslsupport@sandia.gov Task SC-22-03 – Lisa is reaching out to Kansas City to get their metrics. Amber Romero - Are there NDAs between the sites? Not convinced that it is needed to share performance metrics. What she understands is that there needs to be one between each site (i.e. Kansas City to Sandia, Sandia to

LANL, etc.). That may be the hesitation that the NDAs need to be in place. She could be wrong but wants to be sure we have it in place if needed.

Bill Wingfield – At Pantex WQA Forum it was revealed that not all sites Standards & Calibration Labs (SCLs) are getting suppliers to sign disclosure agreements. The 8 NSE sites have committed to this and it is in their procedures. We can add it to the task to explore the EFCOG led process.

Ryan Hoving (in chat) – the NDA question came up on the ANL side as well.

Melissa Flury – Kansas City and Sandia have an NDA, but not sure if it covers this. For NSE Sites, the new ACD on Supplier Quality Audits came out. There will be a MOCA (between Sandia, LANL and Kansas City) that will spell out what the supplier metrics are supposed to look like. When we audit suppliers and they are already in our system, then when we go to them at their 3-year renewal, if they have/have had excellent performance they will get a reduced audit.

Lisa Enstrom – Has been in touch with Kansas City. They have put info together and need it to go through classification process before it is sent. That was 3 weeks ago. She will follow up to be sure all is in place accordingly. Ron Natali – Feels like this is getting too far in the woods. There was an overarching set of documents that encompassed all of this and all approvals were already granted. Why not put in place for EFCOG an NDA document that we are going to share information and it is done. He had a supplier that declined to share and he was restricted on sharing. There are things in the overarching document to have in place that would give us a better playing field and more comfortable. He would be willing to help as needed.

Consuelo Tracy (in chat) – Thought NDAs were in place when we moved to MSL
