Boeing issue – Two possible reasons are 1) Doors were installed incorrectly and plugs were incorrect size OR 2) when maintenance was performed, plugs were not bolted correctly. Investigation is underway to pinpoint the cause. I should also mention that we (EHSS-23) have a Community of Practice in person meeting Save the Date for the week of June 24th through the 28th.
