Industry Supplier Issues / Feedback

SME'S ON SUPPLIER AUDITS – Helps with Cost Avoidances & Good Business Practice

DOT Packaging suppliers - If you are doing an audit of a DOT packaging supplier. You need to have a DOT SME along for the audit, or at least an a DOT checklist provided to a QA auditor who has been trained in DOT. It's a good idea to interview the SME to make sure of his qualifications.

Welding programs – If you are doing an audit of a supplier who is doing welding or providing welding materials you need to have a CWI or similar type welding SME.

There may be cases where you need to bring both a DOT and Welding SME. If no specialized welding is required you may not need a Welding SME.

Title: SUSPECT COUNTERFEIT, DIGIKEY LABEL AND PAPERWORK Abstract: On 22-March-2023, DigiKey Electronics-Shanghai was contacted by a person (person's name unknown) claiming to be Beijing Guangyuan Jiarui Technology Co., Ltd. through webchat, asking what information is on a DigiKey label and for an example of a DigiKey delivery note. The person claiming to be Beijing Guangyuan Jiarui Technology Co., Ltd. provided a photo of what appeared to be a DigiKey pre-pack label and what appeared to be a DigiKey invoice/pack-slip. The DigiKey representative attempted to gather more information to verify the origin of the label and paperwork. The DigiKey representative wanted more information to solve the issue but was unable to reach the caller with the phone number provided. The DigiKey representative became suspicious and contacted DigiKey headquarters, USA. DigiKey headquarters, USA, investigated the information on the label provided, and identified several incorrect or missing fields which confirmed the label to be counterfeit. For example, traceability and identifying information are partially unreadable; part ID is crossed off, but the first two digits are '10'. The part ID for this product does not begin with '10'. Additionally, DigiKey had never received the date and/or lot code that was depicted on the label. No order shipped from DigiKey for the product ID depicted on the label and packlist. DigiKey concludes the label and paperwork are not authentic to DigiKey, and confirms they were misrepresented to appear as if they came from DigiKey. October 23, 2023

Subject: GIDEP Suspect Counterfeit Doc's between 09-OCT-2023 and 13-OCT-2023 * * * * * DOC=AS4-A-24-01 CEDATE=11-OCT-2023 DD=AL Title: SUSPECT COUNTERFEIT NETWORK INTERFACE CARD Abstract: A COTS assembly with Part Number (PN) I350T4V2BLK and Description of Intel Ethernet Server Adapter I350-T4 was procured from the Supplier, Cornerstone Supply Inc. (Cornerstone Supply). The Supplier provided Boeing with a quantity of 4 of the aforementioned PN. Upon Boeing's receipt at the field site of 2 of the 4 assemblies, an Engineer reviewed the containers' contents for their usage in a planned workorder and noticed the lack of an Intel logo, out of the ordinary Chinese writing on the packaging, and abnormal components on the assembly. These assemblies were immediately guarantined and Boeing promptly began an investigation with respect to them. Boeing's investigation included its review of the INTEL website to examine these anomalies, including whether the assemblies could potentially be suspect counterfeit. This led to the review of GIDEP Production Change Notice (PCN) # X1-C-20-3205 issued by Intel on 21 February 2019, which included this suspect Part Number. In the course of Boeing's investigation, Boeing engaged with Intel, and Intel determined that these 4 assembles were not manufactured by them (Intel) based on the following: 1) the MAC Addresses noted above (date code discrepancy where sub-component lot date codes were after the date code within the MAC Address), 2) the lack of an Intel logo on the printed circuit board, and 3) the lack of either a YottaMark or BradyID Anti -Counterfeit label. By using this information, Intel helped establish that these assemblies were suspect counterfeit and were not manufactured by them (Intel) or any Intel suppliers. Based on the obtained information, Boeing believes to have received suspect counterfeit assemblies, from Cornerstone Supply, which came from NEWEGG. Pictures show the discrepancies found with these assemblies. Note 1: Cell 9: Manufacture Date of 200 from the MAC Address is the 20th week of 2020. That is the start date based on the suspect assemblies we possess. However, there may be additional manufacturing dates that are also suspect. Note 2: Cell 10: Manufacture Date of 200 from the MAC Address is the 20th week of 2020. That is the end date based on the suspect assemblies we possess. However, there may be additional manufacturing dates that are also suspect. Note: The manufacturer identified is the entity whose product may have been counterfeited. This reporting convention is necessary to facilitate GIDEP database searches for suspect counterfeit products and is by no means intended to imply that the manufacturer is involved with the suspect product.

***** DOC=B2G-A-23-01 CEDATE=11-OCT-2023 DD=AL Title: SUSPECT COUNTERFEIT, HDSP-9632, 32-CHANNEL ADAT PCI AUDIO INTERFACE Abstract: Resion purchased 35 units of P/N HDSP-9632? 32-Channel ADAT PCI Audio Interface from Hard Disk Direct. These units were purchased for a government contract but did not have manufacturer's traceability. The end customer approved the purchase of October 16, 2023 - 2 - units without traceability provided that Resion sent them to the manufacturer for authentication prior to shipping the parts to the end customer. The units were received in what appeared to be OEM packaging. The units were sent to IMM Manufacturing in Germany. The attached letter states that the parts are counterfeit due to incorrect serial numbers, counterfeit FPGA, hardware was different, incorrect packaging and bar codes. The parts were quarantined at the manufacturer's facility and were not delivered to Resion's end customer. Hard Disk Direct stated that they purchased the units from ODYSSEUS- TRADE LIMITED, a UK company that has since been dissolved. Resion neither confirms nor denies the representations made in the suppliers' responses. To the best of Resion's knowledge, this GIDEP Alert does not contain any untrue statement of fact or omit a statement of fact necessary inorder to make the statements were made) not misleading. This GIDEP Alert does not reflect, nor should it be interpreted, to imply a negative judgment or assessment has been made regarding any manufacturer; or to imply that other products or manufacturers may be preferred. 





- We will be checking the MSL for 'violations' and contacting people individually!
- Kinds of errors found:
 - No auditor name (There should be an Owner name and at least the Lead Auditor name)
 - No start date (if you did an assessment, there is a start date or a scheduled start date and it is indicated on your report. Please use this date)
 - Incorrect site identified (the site should always be the site who did the assessment even if you
 do it for another site)
 - No assessment method (if you did an assessment, there was a way you did it)
 - Not checking to see if supplier already exists and adding same one in a different naming format (Please contact <u>MSLsupport@sandia.gov</u>)
 - Prefer and strongly recommend (but not required) a comment indicating pending SCARs
 - Prefer and <u>strongly recommend</u> (but not required) updating record once SCARs are closed and uploading. It eliminates having to contact the site POC for it which can result in delays.
 - Using the future expiration for 'Event Start Date' when entering a cost avoidance. This should be the date (or approximate) when the original site report was used. The 'Event Complete Date' should be the date (or approximate) when the review of the report was complete.

The new MSL User Manual is complete. All user guides are now in one document. It will be site representatives and posted in MSL. New users receive it upon approval for access.



Who is Eligible to Grant ISO 9001 Certification?

- So who is eligible to grant ISO 9001 certification? Many people assume that ISO grants certification, but in fact, this is not true, instead, a registrar or certification body (CB) will be the one to grant certification (Read: Who is ISO?). When choosing a registrar a supplier should make sure that they are accredited. They should be a member of the International Accreditation Forum (IAF), and additionally need to be ISO/IEC 17021:2015 certified.
- One of these standards is ISO/IEC 17021:2015 Conformity assessment
 "Requirements for bodies providing audit and certification of management systems", which in effect stipulates the requirements for Registrars who certify organizations to ISO management standards like ISO 9001, ISO 14001, etc.
- People often say "ISO Certified" but ISO does not issue certificates or certify individual companies to any standard. So who can Grant ISO 9001 Certification? They are issued by certification/registration bodies (also called Registrars or CB's), which are independent of ISO. CB's need to be accredited by an IAF member to be internationally recognized.
- <u>ISO/IEC 17021</u> ensures international acceptance of the CB's certifications (i.e. your ISO 9001:2008 certificate) by requiring that all Accreditation bodies (<u>ANAB</u>, etc.) belong to an internationally accredited organization, like the <u>IAF</u>. Likewise, the IAF ensures that CB's comply with ISO/IEC 17021.
- Some Quality System Registrars are not accredited by IAF, and thus are not meeting <u>ISO 17021</u> and will not be internationally recognized. Make sure that you <u>choose a Registrar</u> who is accredited by an <u>IAF member</u> (ANAB or the equivalent of ANAB in your country or region).
- 11/2022, Amber Romero checked and we are not allowed to issue AS-9100 certs to our suppliers even if we were accredited, as this would be considered a conflict of interest.


