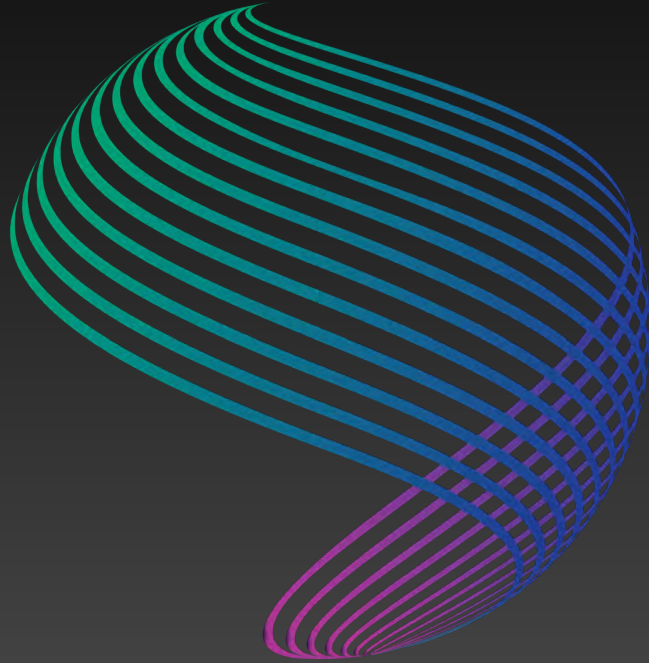

Overview

- CARDS = **C**ourse **A**nd **R**elated **D**ata **S**ystem
- Joint effort between Training EFCOG & NTC
- Launched in 2016
- Online repository of DOE-owned training materials
- Access restricted to other DOE training professionals

Why should I use CARDS?

- Allows sharing of training materials
- Reduces development costs
- Improved content at low cost
- Reduces duplication across DOE
- Saves time and money

Metrics

As of 5/31/2022

- Organizations: 28
- Total number of cards: 9582
- Number of cards with content: 349
- Downloads (last 12 months): 316
- Active users (2022): 46

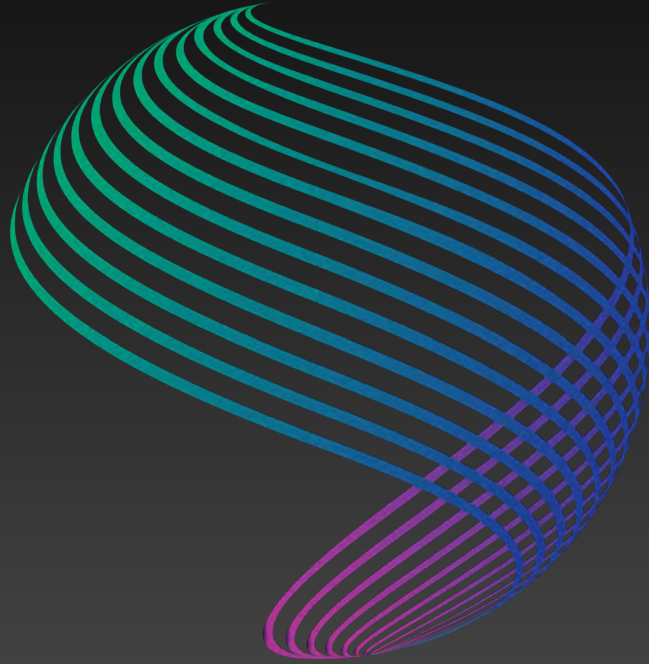



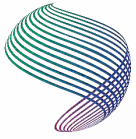
