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Bad habits and how to fix them

Teaching without clear learning objectives.


OBJECTIVES

A key to making courses coherent and tests fair is to write learning objectives – explicit statements of what students should be able to do if they have learned what the instructor wants them to learn - and to use the objectives as the basis for designing lessons, assignments and exams. The objectives should all specify observable actions (e.g., define, explain, calculate, solve, model, critique and design), avoiding vague and unobservable terms like know, learn, understand and appreciate.

OBJECTIVES

- Discuss setting and communicating expectations for the instructor, the course, the class, and the students
- 2. Discuss presenter vs receiver roles
- Identify the methods for receiving presented information (attention) and the hinderances
- 4. Identify and describe how instructor habit patterns can set the student up to fail
- Discuss how conditions established by the organization (outside the control of the instructor) set students up to fail
- 6. Establish the groundwork for future evaluations, observations and discussions to identify and correct instructor bad habits and organizational weaknesses




Not creating clear expectations.

Failure to provide variety in instruction...i.e. turning the class into PowerPoint shows.

Cold calling on students.

Calling for volunteers without giving them time to think about the answer.

Not understanding the desired outcome.

Giving tests that are overly complicated or don't follow the objectives.
